



Marathon world record

A Running the marathon is an important sports event. Most participants do not run a marathon to win. They just want to finish. Sometimes people run a marathon for a cause and others just because they like it. Anyone can run, or is that true? Can anyone run? Man or woman, boy or girl, young or old? Is there an age limit?

Well, Shigetsugu Anan and his wife Miyoko, both from Japan, set a world record in January 2008. They are the oldest couple to run the Ibusuki Nanohana Marathon. On the day they ran, Shigetsugu was 83 years and 11 days old, and his wife was 78 years and 71 days old!



After the race they both felt a little tired, which is understandable, but what is very surprising is that, just after an hour or so, they went straight home to make plans for the next competition.

So, believe it or not, you might hear of them very soon. Who knows? They might come to Greece, too, to run the *real* marathon!





WIKIPEDIA


Can readers write their own encyclopedia? Believe it or not, they can! This is what Wikipedia is all about. The people who write for it are people like you and me, not lexicographers, teachers, or university professors.

Wikipedia is a free electronic encyclopedia with information about anything you can think of and you can find it on the Internet. Born in 2001, now it has more than ten million texts, in about two hundred and fifty languages! Two million of these are in English.

To write, add or correct information, you simply click on the text and do it. Anyone can add anything, any time, for as many times as he or she wants.

Today, there are more than seventy five thousand Wikipedia writers around the world and statistics show that they make about 1.000 changes per hour. Up to now, about 700 million visitors have actually used it.

Wikipedia is amazing! Readers add information to it 365 days a year. It is a



'live' encyclopedia but you need to remember that not all information you can find in it is correct. Sometimes the information you find is not right because nobody checks to make sure that what readers add is correct. So, don't think that it can replace a real encyclopedia in the library or from an electronic site.
